On July 8, 2025, a training on gender equality and justice was organized at ORBIT at Humnabad for the members of the internal gender equality team of three partner Organizations led by KROSS Bangalore. Fr Victor Vas, The Director of ORBIT emphasized that if women wanted to come forward, they must be aware of justice and involve themselves in the struggle for organization. Sister Nancy Lobo the State **Advisor, Women Empowerment** Bangalore, convinced the participants about the difference between gender and sexuality. Then Rev Fr Richard Pais, the Director KROSS Bangalore, emphasized that gender equality needs to be brought in many areas, namely the social field, the economic field, the political field and the cultural field. If equality is to be brought in all areas, its basic strategy is education and awareness. On the second day of the training workshop, Sr Christina the Project Manager the guest speaker of the day spoke at the beginning of the training and talked about children's rights, right to life, right to freedom, right to equality. She gave detailed information to women about free legal aid. Through several activities she made the training successful. 41 trainees from three organizations participated in this training and got the information on free legal services and gender equality.

“Training on Global Warming”

On 01 July 2025, a training on global warming was organized by Cauvery and Bhagyashree Self Help Group in Joladapka village of Bhalki Taluk. This training started with a prayer song. Smt. Premalatha welcomed. Mr. Prabhudas clearly explained in the meeting of the association what global warming is. It means that the sudden increase in the sun and untimely rains, the decrease in the atmosphere and the cyclones that occur due to this are very harmful to people. The reason for this is the increase in population and the environment. This is very harmful to people. This is due to urbanization. We see deforestation etc. Everyone can take responsibility for the environment and prevent these disasters. “The Woman, Who Developed Leadership Qualities and Became Self-Employed Through Training.”

I am Mamita Ganda Sundar, a resident of Sitalagera village. I had no experience of what a Self-Help Group is and how it works. Initially, four Self Help Group (SHGs) were formed by the Animators ORBIT. After forming the SHGs, I had defined their goals and objectives. Similarly, the four SHGs were brought together and formed Udaya Mahasangha. After the formation of the

Mahasangha, we developed leadership qualities and were able to take up the problems of the village and visit the Gram Panchayat and submit applications to solve our problems. They have encouraged us by providing self-employment training. Now I have bought tailoring machine and am now sewing beds, from which I am earning 200 to 300 per day. The children in our family are studying well and everyone are happy. It is Possible because of ORBIT hence I express my heartfelt gratitude to ORBIT on behalf of myself and my family.

“Training on the Leadership Responsibilities of the Maha Sangha and the Importance of the Environment”

On 12 July 2025, ORBIT Mrs. Savita organized a Gandhi Mahasangha meeting in Kapargaon village of Humnabad taluk under the ORBIT. It is a very happy thing that the resource person, Sr. Edna, is conducting a



meeting with six SHGs in the Gandhi Mahasangha. As the representatives of the Mahasangha, they should not depend on anyone and the office bearers of each SHGs should take responsibility and conduct the meeting in the best possible way by being punctual. The Mahasangha members should show your leadership and your voice up to the Taluk, District and State level Federations. In this way, by growing step by step, leadership qualities will develop in everyone and everyone will be self-disciplined. He encouraged them to do their part. “Meeting of the Association of the DPOs (Differently Abled Persons Organizations)”

On 08 July 2025, a visit was made to Nimbur village and the homes of mentally ill persons were visited to inquire about their health. After that, a meeting was held with the Ambedkar DPOs. About 60 to 70 percent of the beneficiaries who had recovered after taking the medication were given free financial assistance and Goats to start self-employment. They should take advantage of this and improve their lives. And increase the economic status of the family. To lead the life of a good citizen in the society, Mr. David the Animator informed the beneficiaries who came to the meeting. The members of the association who received the information expressed their heartfelt gratitude to the Director of the organization for taking care of their lives and showing compassion.



On 09 July 2025, a meeting of the Jyoti DPOs was held at Ánjari colony, Humnabad city. In this meeting, the members of the association were made aware about the environment. The environment is a fundamental aspect of our life. It is necessary for every person to participate in the protection of the environment. Nature is the source of our life. We cannot live if the environment is damaged. Everyone should take the responsibility of protecting nature. It provides us with air to breathe, drinking water and food to grow. “Information about Mental Illness, Free Medicine in Government Hospital”

On 10 July 2025, the information on mental health and illness and the availability of the free medicines at Govt Hospitals was given to the people of Kanakatta village in Humnbad. A total of 15 members were informed and pamphlets were also distributed to them. If you see people with symptoms of mental illness in your village, kindly bring them to the government hospital. Every Wednesday from 10 am to 1:00 pm. Therefore, if you see people with mental illness in your village or elsewhere, you should help your villagers so that they get treatment.



On 08 July 2025, in Sedol Gram Panchayat of Humnabad Taluk, awareness was made about mental illness among women in employment. In this program, Mrs. Mahadevi the Animator made 48 people aware about mental illness. And informed them about the facilities available in the government Hospital. Mental illness is a brain disease; there is medicine for this disease. Every Wednesday, a doctor comes to the government hospital, checks mental illness and gives them medicine for a month. So, if there is anyone in your village, tell them. It was told that every Wednesday, a doctor comes to the government hospital of Humnabad Taluk, examines their condition and gives them free medicine.

“One-day Workshop on Livelihood Skills Training Program”

On 17 July 2025, a one-day livelihood skills training Program was organized for the beneficiaries at ORBIT at Humnabad. Mr. Shantakumar Siddeshwar, a Veterinary Officer was the Resource Person for this workshop and gave complete information to the beneficiaries on how to rear the Goats, how many types of Goats there are, how many breeds there are and how to manage them. A total of 36 beneficiaries and staff of ORBIT participated in this training workshop and benefited from it.



“Field-Based Staff Capacity Building Training”

On July 14.15. 2025, a two-day field-based staff capacity building training was organized for the staff of the Navajeevana program supported by Azim Premji Foundation in Kallur, Dummansur and Indiranagar villages of Humanabad. In this



training, Mr. Santosh, Divisional Manager of APD Institute, provided training as a Resource Person. Listening to the problems of the family members, guiding them accordingly and helping them find solutions. And the workers should have complete information about the treatment. Because it will help in providing treatment to the beneficiaries in a way that does not cause any problems.



“Intimate Counseling of Community Based Rehabilitation Program”

The field-based individual counseling of the Mentally Ill Person-Based Rehabilitation Program organized in Halikheda (B) town of Humnabad taluk on July 2025. The beneficiaries of the Primary Health Center Halikheda (B) underwent a counselling. The main issues raised by the beneficiaries during the counselingi were: Many times, I forget to take my medicine. There is a lot of pressure from the family and sometimes my father, mother, children and wife do not respond to our requests. Everyone in the family feels like I am alone. The financial situation in our family is deteriorating. Since there is no work in our life, we are not able to manage the expenses. I hope to get good health in the coming days. Therefore, many times in close counseling and continuous treatment and follow the advice of the psychiatrist is needed. When the new beneficiaries are given the counseling, they are given courage, self-confidence and strength. They are also allowed to participate in other training. Therefore, I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to ORBIT and the entire team



“Meeting of the Parents' Association of Differently abled Persons”

On 08 July 2025, a meeting of the Jai Shri Balaji Differently abled person's Association was held in Ghataborala village of Humanabad. In this meeting, Mrs. Pooja, the Animator of ORBIT, addressed the meeting to a total of 6 members present in the meeting. Information was given about the daily activities of mentally ill persons, their health, the role of the family in continuous treatment, and how the members of the meeting should come together and advocate and lobby in the context of unavailability of medicines.

“Early Intervention and Early Education Program”



“Center-Based Intervention for Children with Developmental Delays”

On 17 July 2025, in Molkera village of Humnabad taluk, Early intervention and Early Education staff Mrs. Kavita, with the help of workers, taught children with developmental disabilities to write using numbers and letters and speak using two letters Daddy, Mummy etc. through a center-based activity at the Anganwadi center. At the center, disabled children were taught to mix with other children and do activities. They were taught the names of colors and how to make sounds by showing pictures of animals. They were taught to identify the names of parts of the body. It was informed that it is very important for parents to also do activities for children at home every day.

“Home-Based Activities for Children with Developmental Delays”

On 15 July 2025, a home-based activity was conducted for children with developmental disabilities under the Early intervention and Early Education Program in Hunsanal village of Humnabad taluk. Children were taught crawling activity, sitting activity, observing one side, standing activity along with writing skills and reading skills. Children were given an activity to identify colors and identify vegetables used in the house based on colors. Children were told to do activities at home daily by their parents. It was told that more emphasis should be placed on playing through games and with things they like so that children are interested.



“Awareness Program on Early Intervention and Early Education”

On 16 July 2025, at Hallikheda (B) Sub-Center of Humnabad Taluk, Mrs. Mamata, the Animator of the Early intervention and Early Education Program of ORBIT, spoke about the major problems faced by children with developmental disabilities. Many problems can be seen in children such as vision, size, shape, number concept, speech development, physical development. Inform ORBIT when our children are not doing their daily activities independently. It was told that we will teach children about their activities through evaluation. A total of 22 people from the community participated in this program and took advantage of it.

“Counseling Session”

On 24.7.2025, counselor Rupali conducted an intimate counseling session for Chandrakala of Gokul village. In this, she shared the pain she is experiencing as a mother to her mentally ill son Pradeep. She was very emotional for giving enough time to listen to his pain at a time when no one else had time to listen to his pain and shared her experience that the burden of his pain has been lifted.

On July 23, a meeting of caregivers was held at in Kasartugaon village of Bhalki taluk. The meeting was chaired by Mr Pradeep, staff of Navajeevana LLLF. Addressing the parents present in the meeting, he discussed the daily activities of mentally ill people, their health, the role of the family in continuous treatment, and how the members of the meeting can collectively advocate for their rights in cases where they are not getting enough medication. A total of 8 parents took advantage of the meeting.





On 21-07-2025, Mr Arun, a staff of ORBIT Navajeevana LLLF program, conducted training on mental health for all ASHA workers at the Primary Health Center in Godampalli village of Bidar taluk. Our ORBIT organisation has been leading various projects continuously for about 31 years. And has been a light for the poor families. Also, for the last two years, community-based rehabilitation projects have been being implemented for mental illnesses. The main objective is to remove the superstition and stigma associated with mental illness and create awareness.

Motto: The main objective is to give priority to those with mental illness in the workplace. Every job puts pressure on a person. Due to excessive work, a person experiences symptoms like anxiety, fear and depression. This illness is a brain disorder. If such a disorder is found, contact a psychiatrist and get proper treatment. Awareness was created about the treatment. You run around the community conducting surveys. If such a disease is found, awareness should be created about superstitions such as witchcraft, magic, mantra, stigma. Many things were said. A total of 45 people including Cho, phco, Hio & Administrative Medical Officer participated in this program.



On the 25th, a Vana Mahotsava was celebrated in Muchalamba village along with the families of mentally ill people under the LLLF program by Sr. Christina and worker Mrs. Mahadev by distributing saplings. Speaking on the occasion, Sr. Christina said that trees and vines are our lifelines and it is our duty to protect them. If our lifeline is to flourish, there should be saplings around us. She wished everyone and distributed saplings, marking the special occasion of the festival.



Mrs. Lalitha, a resident of Badalgaon village, had been suffering from mental illness for about 10 years and was being treated in a hospital in Maharashtra. She was persuaded to get treatment at the Aurad Government Hospital. Since her husband Jeevan had to work alone and earn a living, she and Lalitha had not been taking the pills properly for the past 20 days and would start vomiting if they gave her pills. Mr. Rafiq, the coordinator of the LLLF program, visited her house on July 19 to explain to ORBIT that Jeevan was tired and was successful in giving her pills. He also convinced her to take the pills daily.



On 01-07-2025, in Markhal village of Bidar district, A meeting of the Special Needs Association was organized under Navajeevana program supported by Live Love Laugh foundation. Mr. Anand, the staff of ORBIT, participated and spoke in this meeting. The main objective of this meeting is to promote equality and help the Special Needs to fully participate in the society. Important points discussed in the meeting: Social security schemes such as UDID Card. Monthly pension, (IGNDPS), 5% grant in Gram Panchayat, Health schemes, Health care., Management of daily activities, Advocacy and Benefits. Information was given on the following topics. A total of 12 people including the PHCO of the health sub-center, Anganwadi center workers, ASHA workers, and special needs persons participated in this meeting.



A health camp (DMHP) was conducted under the District Mental Health Programme (DMHP) at the Government Hospital of Auradhapura Taluk on July 4. In this camp, psychiatrists provided personal counseling to the beneficiaries and distributed pills to them for their development. On this occasion, the staff of ORBIT cooperating with the psychiatrists, provided treatment to many mentally ill people identified and provided them with a helping hand. They were also brought together and informed about their health and daily activities.

An awareness program for the mentally ill was organized in Allama Prabhunagar, Bidar taluk on 05-07-2025. Mr.



Nohan, staff of Navajeevana LLLF spoke about the mentally ill. Mental illness is a brain disease; in recent days many people are suffering from this disease. People are becoming mentally ill due to anxiety, work pressure. Such as talking to oneself, laughing, crying, insomnia, loneliness, apathy, depression, anger, rage, fighting are symptoms found in mentally ill people. People were made aware that if they find anyone with such symptoms, they should inform us, we will come and visit them and the government will provide free check-up and free treatment. A total of 12 people, including PHCOs, ASHA workers and others, participated in this awareness program for the mentally ill.



On 23/07/2025, LLLF program worker Mr Kumar provided health card/e-shrama card and pension to the beneficiaries of mental illness in Joladapaga village of Bhalki taluk. When no one was able to provide him with work, ORBIT provided us with a pension system that would be useful for our livelihood and guided us at every stage. We express our heartfelt gratitude to them and share our heartfelt feelings.

A health camp (DMHP) was held at the Basavakalyan taluk government hospital on July 14. In this camp, the staff of ORBIT collaborated with psychiatrists to provide treatment to the mentally ill. They helped them to draw cards according to their needs and along with that, they were given appropriate guidance. It was also ensured that many mentally ill people identified were treated. The medical officers and others have expressed their appreciation for their cooperation in this government work through their service.



Today, on 23.7.2025, Mr. Yohan, staff of Navajeevana LLLF organised an awareness program on cancer and mental illness in Bedkunda village of Kamalnagar taluk. He said that due to some unfortunate incident in life, a person becomes a victim of mental illness. If this illness is detected and given appropriate treatment, the personality can improve. Their symptoms are crying for no reason, laughing, roaming the streets, getting angry, loneliness, hearing something, etc.

Similarly, cancer is a disease that is becoming increasingly common in today's society. When symptoms of this disease appear, it is better to seek advice from a doctor and get proper treatment. This cancer can be cured if detected early and treated. The main causes of cancer are smoking, alcohol, gutkha, bid and cigarette smoking. Especially, breast and uterine cancer are more likely in women. It was informed that it is important to seek advice from a doctor as soon as any changes are noticed in the body of girls. 12 people participated in this awareness program.



On 17/07/25, at Gudupalli village in Bidar taluk, Mrs. Deepika spoke about how a person suffering from mental illness can be cured by providing continuous treatment. We conduct a camp at Basavakalyan Taluk Hospital every Tuesday. Here, we conduct free check-ups for the mentally ill. We visit them at their homes every month to check whether they are taking their pills properly or not, and we inform their parents accordingly. In case they are not taking the pills, I request their parents to give them the pills secretly, i.e., in their meals or tea or in

their sambar, because the main goal of our ORBIT organization is that they should lead a happy life in the society like you and me. By doing this, they can come out of their daily sickness. A total of 15 people, including psychiatrists and villagers, participated in this program and took advantage of this program.



Mr. Peter, staff of ORBIT, conducted a survey of 300 houses in July and identified about 12 mentally ill people and made them aware of treatment. During his survey, he went door to door and informed them about the treatment of mentally ill people. Although many special needs were found in this survey, they were also informed about the facilities provided by our organization and the facilities that should be provided to them by the government. In this, it was found that ASHA workers cooperated and recognized our organization.



On 11/07/2025, an awareness program on mental illness was organized for the girls of Sanga in Halahalli village of Halasur taluk by bringing them together in anganwadi. Speaking on the occasion, Mrs. Lakshmi, the resource person of this program, said that ORBIT, is a social service organization and many social service programs are being conducted, Women Development Scheme, Samriddhi program, Early intervention and early education. For the last four years, the organization has been working with more than 3000 mentally ill people and their parents in coordination with the District Mental Health Program. We are trying to identify the mentally ill persons and bring them into the mainstream of the society.

They were informed that if anyone was suffering from mental illness, they should inform them. They were also asked to call the helpline number 9036664271. 40 people participated in this awareness program and received information.



In Bidarnaman, ORBIT staff visited the police station in the village of Samyukashraya under Navajeevana program supported by live love laugh foundation and organized an awareness program for the officers there. In this program, they were informed about how to manage the pressure that falls on them during their work, how to take care of themselves physically and mentally in daily activities and how to maintain their mental well-being. It was requested that pamphlets be distributed to each officer in their work area. The officers appreciated

our service and the concern they have for the police.

“Sevasangama Gulbarga Program”

“Awareness Program on Early Intervention and Early Education”

On July 18, 2025, at the Government Higher Primary School in Hunnakirangi village of Kalaburagi district, A training was given to 5th and 6th grade students on the Early and Early Education Program. The child should cry immediately after birth, otherwise the child will be stunted. The child's neck should be erect at three months. The child should sit and crawl at 9 months. At 1 year, the child should learn to walk without anyone's help. At 2 years, the child should completely say the names of the family members and the child should adapt to the home environment. At 6 years, the child should go to school and learn letters and should integrate into the social circle. If all these above factors are not found in the child, then it should be understood that the child is stunted in the stages of development of the child, said Seva Sangama Stad Mrs. Dakshayani, who informed a total of 50 students.



“Assistive Devices Distribution Program”

On July 5, at the Mother Teresa Hall in Kalaburagi, a program was organized by Riseboionics, Bangalore. The divine presence and presidency of the program was taken up by Bishop Robert Michael Meranda, the president of ORBIT and Seva Sangama. He distributed the equipment and said that as per the saying "Body is the highest goal, duty is the highest goal", Seva Sangama is working for the development of the society. On this occasion, Seva Sangama, honored the members of the team by presenting them with shawls.



Speaking at the program, Mr. Sanirama Riseboionics, Bangalore said that the work of Seva Sangama is commendable. The introductory remarks were made by Fr. Victor Vas, Director, Seva Sangama Kalaburagi. Mrs. Manisha Rice, Biomedical Engineering Institute, Bangalore, Mr. Sanjeev Kulkarni, District Coordinator, Azim Premji Foundation, Mr. Khaja Hussain, Sakhya Institute, Bangalore, Fr. Praveen Joseph were present on the stage. A total of 100 people including parents and children participated in the program.

“Awareness Program”

On July 12, 2025, awareness program was organised at Janagegalli Anganwadi. In the program it was told how to identify children with developmental delays between the ages of 0 and 6 under the Early intervention and Early Education program. After identification, the severity of the disability can be gradually reduced by doing various activities for the children. Such children complain that various facilities are provided by the government, and Mrs. Shivakantha, an Anganwadi worker, Mrs. Nirmala and 8 women participated in the information program.



“Training for Parents of Children with Developmental Delays”

On July 05, 2025, at the Mother Teresa Auditorium in Kalaburagi, a training session for parents was organized by Sakhya Foundation under the Early Intervention and Early Education Program. we identify the deficiencies in children between the ages of 0-6 years very early and provide them with practical training to the parents on how to reduce the

deficiencies of the child using the materials available at home through such activities. He said that since the parents have more time with the child, the deficiencies in the child can be reduced step by step by giving the child more activities.



“Awareness Program”

On 21 July 2025, an awareness program on Early intervention and Early Education program was organized at the Government Higher Primary School in Hatagunda village of Kalaburagi taluk in association with Seva Sangama. How to identify children with developmental delays between the ages of 0-6. Information was given on how to provide activities to the identified children. How to provide center-based activities for children, what is its use, and how important is center-based activities, and how to take advantage of the Chetana centre under Savalagi Panchayat. Kumari Lakshmi told 19 students about the changed children through the example of children.
